

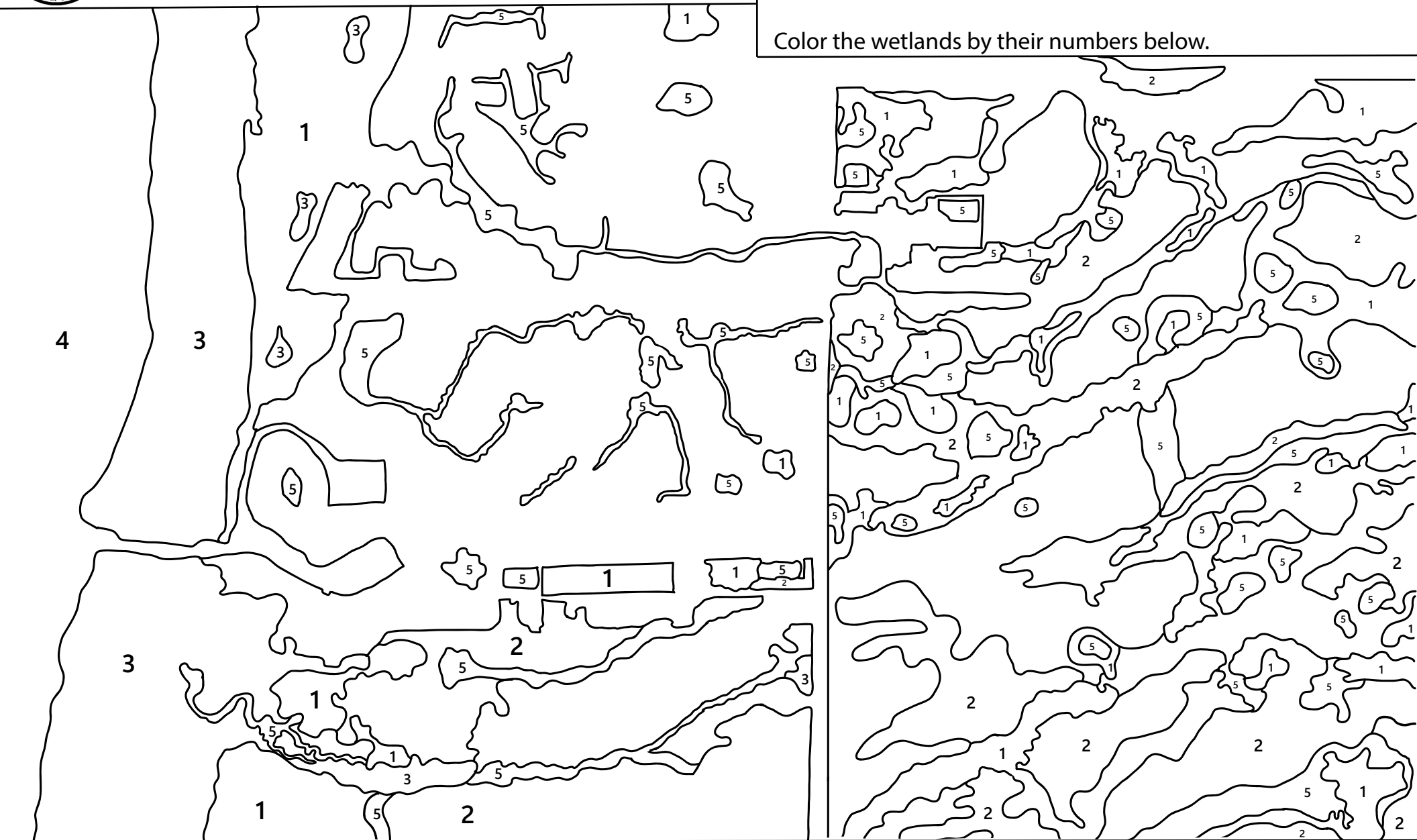


National Wetlands Inventory Map

WETLANDS ACROSS A LANDSCAPE

This is an example of a wetlands map! This map shows how many different types of wetlands can exist in an area, including wetlands with different types of plants and amounts of water. Wetlands can be found in lots of different landscapes!

Color the wetlands by their numbers below.



1 - Light Green

Light green wetlands represent areas that are freshwater marshes. These areas are often filled with water and covered in grass-like plants.

2 - Dark Green

Dark green represents forested wetlands which have a lot of trees growing in them.

3- Light Blue

Light blue represents saltwater wetlands, which are found where land meets the ocean. These include salt marshes and mangroves.

4 - Dark Blue

Dark blue represents deepwater ocean areas. These areas have waves and currents.

5 - Purple

These areas are ponds and rivers, which are wet for most of the year, and have wetland plants like lily pads and cattails.
